Students will be trained to size-up (physical state, hazards, initial hot zone, correct meters and PPE) of any chemical in seconds. The system uses a streamlined methodology to build upon the initial size-up, preparing them to immediately go to work when they arrive on a Hazardous Materials/WMD event.
