The City of Junction City Fire Department is accepting applications for the position of:

Firefighter/EMT

Base Pay:

Firefighter/EMT \$13.85 Per Hour, 24 Hours On/ 48 Hours Off

Firefighter/AEMT \$15.32 Per Hour, 24 Hours On/ 48 Hours Off

Firefighter/ EMT-Paramedic \$16.73 Per Hour, 24 Hours On/ 48 Hours Off

This work involves training under close supervision for the protection of life and property by Firefighting, EMS and Rescue activities. A major portion of time is spent training and studying methods, techniques, and organization, as well as routine duties in the maintenance of department property and equipment.

Junction City Fire Department (JCFD) is a Fire based EMS system the minimum of the First Year with the Department will be working as an EMS Technician at the level of qualification at the time of hire.

Specific orders and directions are given by supervising officer.

Examples of Work Performed:

Must successfully complete training in the following areas:

Successfully complete initial EMS qualification induction

Responding to alarms with a fire company.

Entering burning buildings with hose lines.

Operating nozzles and directing water on the fire.

Operating hand fire extinguishers.

Raising, lowering and climbing ladders and ventilating burning buildings.

Removing victims from danger and administering emergency care to injured persons.

Performing salvage operations.

Driving and operating emergency equipment.

Performing routine housekeeping duties at a fire station.

These examples are not intended to be all-inclusive. Other related duties may be assigned as needed.

Requirements of Work:

Possession of and ability to maintain Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) certification EMT; AEMT or EMT- Paramedic

Possession of and ability to maintain a valid Kansas driver's license

Ability to understand and to follow oral and written directions

Ability to read and understand departmental material and to learn a variety of Firefighting, EMS and Rescue duties and methods within a reasonable period

Ability to successfully complete required training

Ability to drive apparatus according to state and local regulations governing operation of emergency vehicles

Ability to discriminate between colors in observing fire and smoke conditions

Ability to cooperate with other workers, to accept lines of authority, and to maintain courteous relationships with the public

Ability to communicate clearly and effectively, both orally and in writing

Ability to complete the selection process which includes an appearance before an oral interview board, a physical examination, and an extensive background check.

An employee shall not pose a direct threat to the health or safety of other individuals in the workplace.

Required Experience and Training:

Applicant must be 21 years of age or older and must be a high school graduate or possess a G.E.D. certificate. Must possess and maintain a Kansas certificate for Emergency Medical Technician, (EMT; AEMT or EMT-Paramedic), Proof of Firefighter qualifications in accordance with NFPA 1001 Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications and valid Kansas driver's license. Offers of employment are contingent upon passing a pre-employment physical, which includes drug screening, and upon satisfactory evaluation of the results of a criminal record check.

Interested candidates are required to submit a complete City of Junction City application along with documentation of a Kansas and/or National Registry EMT certification, and Proof of Firefighter qualifications in accordance with NFPA 1001 Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications

Successful applicants that meet the minimum requirements for the position will be invited to an assessment process.

2. Physical Agility Assessment of Firefighter Skills
3. Oral Interview
